

Notice to Applicant

Section 386J of the *Mineral Resources Act 1989*

This letter is a notice to the applicant under section 386J of the *Mineral Resources Act 1989* requiring them to complete or correct a permit application or provide information with respect to an application. Under 386K of the *Mineral Resources Act 1989* a permit application may be refused if an applicant does not comply with the requirements of this notice.

Take notice that: Pursuant to s. 386J of the *Mineral Resources Act 1989 (MRA)* this notice requires you to undertake the actions prescribed in this notice with respect to the application for Mining Lease number 700060.

After reviewing the supporting information lodged, I have determined that the applicants Queensland Coking Coal Pty Ltd are to complete or correct the application.

This Notice is issued pursuant to section 386J(1)(a) of the MRA and requires the applicants to provide the information specified below by 11 November 2020.

Requirements and Actions

- On review of GeoResGlobe the road reserve overlapping the ML has been identified incorrectly on the land information list.
- Correctly identify the 'land tenure type' and 'land owner name and address' for Lot 26 CNS125.
- Provide a list for the adjoining land parcels (does not include background land parcels).

The application was accompanied by a land information list that appears to be incorrect or incomplete and the land adjoining the ML was not identified correctly at the time of the application. The applicants are required to conduct their own review of the land comprising the ML and the land adjoining the ML and provide an amended land information list and adjoining land list.

You are required to take the abovementioned actions within twenty (20) business days of your receipt of this notice.

If you are unable to complete these actions within the prescribed timeframe you may request an extension of time to comply with the requirements of this notice.

If you fail to comply with this notice within the prescribed timeframe, or your response is not satisfactory, your application may be refused pursuant to section 386K of the MRA.
