


Figure 1-1 Regional Location – Vulcan Coal Mine



Vitrinite Pty Ltd has prepared an Underground Water Impact Report (UWIR) in accordance with the requirements of Section 370 of the *Water Act 2000*. The UWIR relates to the exercise of underground water rights within Mining Lease (ML) 700060, the operating Vulcan Coal Mine. The Vulcan Coal Mine is located approximately 40 kilometers (km) northwest of Dysart and 35 km southeast of Moranbah, in the Bowen Basin (**Figure 1-1**).
