


Figure 1-1 Regional Location – Vulcan South Project



Vitrinite Pty Ltd has prepared an Underground Water Impact Report (UWIR) in accordance with the requirements of Section 370 of the *Water Act 2000*. The UWIR relates to the exercise of underground water rights within Mining Lease (ML) 700073 at the Vulcan South Project. The Vulcan South Project is located approximately 35 km southeast of Moranbah, in the Bowen Basin (**Figure 1-1**).
